Creation of the RSWA Student Medal

The creation of Royal Society Top Student Science Medals for Perth's four public universities was discussed by Council in March 1997.

In 1998 the RSWA inaugurated Student Medals to be awarded every year at its Annual General Meeting to those science students from each of Perth's universities nominated by them as the most outstanding in Natural and Earth Sciences.

The obverse of the medal is the crest of the RSWA. Initially, medals were awarded to students from The University of Western Australia, Curtin University, Murdoch University and Edith Cowan University. The University of Notre Dame was included later.
